

Service Changes to Peers Until the End of March 2020, Effective March 17th, 2020

Due to the COVID 19 virus, we are reorienting our services to increase social distancing. ***Our aim is to decrease contacts while still having opportunities to connect and receive basic supplies.***

Drop In: Services at the drop in centre will be by appointment or by one to one drop in. We will have food, harm reduction supplies and bus tickets to hand out, but we are discouraging folks from entering the centre unless it is an emergency.

Night Outreach: Night Outreach will deliver food and harm reduction supplies on a one to one basis by window service until further notice.

Housing and Harm Reduction Outreach: Staff can be reached by phone during their usual hours and we will be providing phone support and arranging drop off harm reduction and food (and other essentials).

There will be NO GROUPS at Peers Victoria including SACRED, Men's Dinner, Indoor, and Trans and Non-Binary, Night Outreach, Drop in until further notice.
